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Presque Rien Prize Le La en Le (2013)

It was my pleasure to create *Le La en Le* specifically for this call for works. This 9 minute fixed-media work is for two channel playback. There is a special emphasis on lower frequencies in this work so it's preferable to listen on a system with larger speakers or a subwoofer.

Le La en Le was created largely from selections of the Luc Ferrari Tape Archive made available from Presque Rien. These are the recordings from the archive that were used in this work.
